KiteFest 2010

The LibertyFest KiteFest is scheduled for Saturday & Sunday, June 26 -27. We will be flying at Mitch Park located between Kelly and Santa Fe on Covell in Northwest Edmond.

The Kite Festival will include many events for the experienced flyer as well as the novice. We will paint the sky with hundreds of kites flown by anyone who wants to "go fly a kite."

There will be team demonstrations by experienced kites. The two- lined kites are flown in synchronized figures and patterns by three or more kites. There will also be kites flying four-lined kites in patterns never dreamed of by the kites of yesteryear.

The Kite Festival will include kite making for even the youngest kiter and a place to fly their new kite. There will be the opportunity to paint Japanese symbols on your kite. Candy drops from a large kite will occur several times during the day for the kids. Large bags of candy are released from a kite in the sky and the kids may scramble for their share.

Several Master Class kites will demonstrate new kites and flying techniques.

We will also have the past president of the American Kitefliers Association, Richard Dermer from Stillwater, Oklahoma displaying miniature kites. Several traction kites will pull their buggies with kites.

All of these festivities and many others will take place at Mitch Park between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Saturday, June 26, 2010.

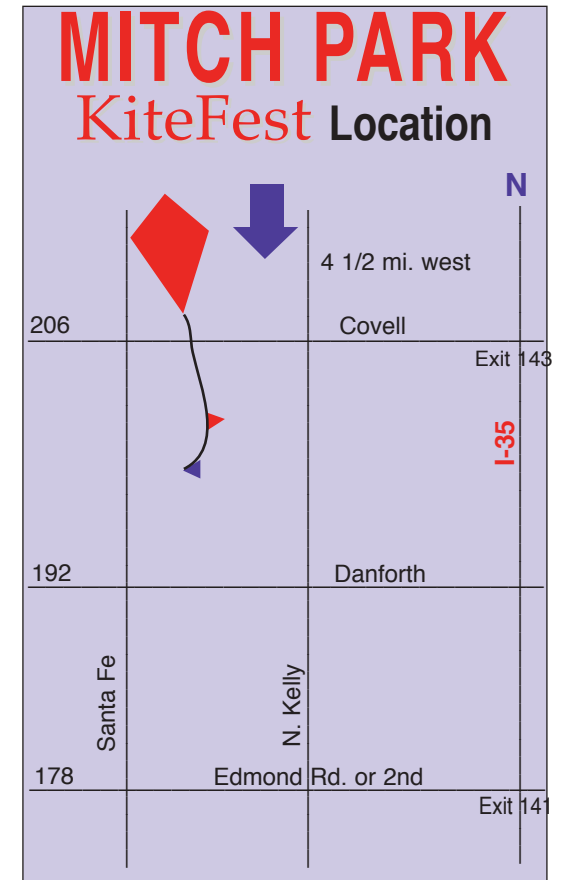
After sundown the kites will return and do a night-fly. Lights will be placed on the two-lined kites and flown together. Many have described this as an experience with UFO's. This is a "must see" for those who have never witnessed a night kite fly and for those who have. Sunday, June 27th , from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. is dedicated to kite flying. Everyone is invited to bring or buy a kite from our vendor and watch the kite flying.

So, for a fun filled two days of kite flying or just kite watching, come to Mitch Park and join us. Many kites will be there to show everyone the latest in kites and kite flying and answer any questions about kites. Maybe we'll even get you to try your "hands" at flying a two-lined kite.
