Each entry has a presentation and judging criteria.
A total of 5 points for each judging criterion (with 5 points being the highest).

Floats: Civic-Non-Profit/Business Sponsored:

1. Decorated platform built on a vehicle/truck or pulled behind one. OK Vehicle wrap on pulling vehicle.
2. Must be Decorated, Theme Oriented, Unique, Crowd Pleasing, Patriotic, Fun.
3. **One (1) Float** with riders or walkers allowed with each entry application.
4. Riders on the Float must have hand holds for safety.
5. Float must have **working ABC fire extinguisher** on board.
6. Trailer hitches must be secure and sufficient to handle the trailer being pulled and subject to inspection.
7. Staging areas on the East side of UCO: Baumann St. and Ayers.
8. Points awarded: 1-5

Equestrian/Horse Group/Animal (Individual and Group): We DO NOT provide veterinarian services.

1. Organized groups, uniformed, costumed or theme riders are welcome.
2. Only **PARADE EXPERIENCED** riders and their horses are allowed.
3. Meet your group, unload and prepare your horses in the parking lots located on the East side of Chad Richison Stadium (UCO football stadium) adjacent to Chowing Street. Enter Chowing Street from the North, at University Dr or Danforth St. Parade Marshals will direct you to your line-up number and Final staging in the Parade.
4. Help clean up animal waste in the staging area.
5. Points awarded: 1-5

Horse/Animal drawn wagon/buggy: We DO NOT provide veterinarian services.

1. Quality, well maintained wagons/buggy with parade experienced drivers and animals.
2. Staging area is the same as Equestrian/Animal (see above)
3. Help clean up animal waste in the staging area.
4. Points awarded: 1-5

Marching: (Bands, Military, Flag Corps, Scouts):

1. Co-ordinated costume or uniform is welcome.
2. Other units considered based on entertainment value or uniqueness
3. Meet, Park and assemble in the parking lots around the UCO Wellness Center/Fieldhouse. Enter off of University Street, north of Ayers Street.
4. Points awarded: 1-5



Car/Vehicle/Motorcycles (individual and groups/clubs);

1. Vintage, Classic, Antique, Custom Cars
2. Motorcycle clubs
3. Tractor Individual and Groups/Clubs
4. Military Vehicles
5. No 'For Sale' signs.
6. **No Advertising Vehicle wraps on individual entrants.**
7. Current political office holders or Designated group Ms., Mrs. winners use this category.
8. Minimum of 4 and maximum of 14 units
9. Points awarded: 1-5
